

General Information for Big Sur & Morro Bay Campouts

Attendance: Limited to 50 campers who will be supported by 12 counselors and 5 supervisors.

Transportation: 15 passenger vans (driven by camp supervisors certified with California Commercial Chauffer Licenses), 9 passenger SUV's, and a luggage truck!

Camping: Pfeiffer Big Sur Campground, and Morro Bay State Park Campground. While these are public campgrounds, our groups will be cohesive staying in group sites or campsites clustered together. After registering your child for either of these campouts we will provide you with our exact sites at each campground and our emergency contact information.

Meals: Our meals will be cooked on a camp stove or over a campfire. Drinking water will always be available for campers. Meals vary each day, but always make a well balanced diet including fresh fruits and vegetables.

Activities: Itineraries for both campouts are available online (please note these are subject to change due to weather and other factors). Each day holds new adventures for our campers as they explore the central coast of California hiking, kayaking, swimming, horseback riding and more.

To Bring to for Campout:

- **Clothes for cold, foggy Big Sur.** Think layers: t-shirt, long sleeve shirt, hooded sweatshirt. Shorts, long pants, swim suit. Closed toed shoes, socks (extras to sleep in!), and sandals. Hat and sunscreen if it gets hot. A red hooded Camp Ocean Pines sweatshirt is available for \$25.
- **Toiletries.** We are camping in tents, but there are showers/bathrooms nearby. Showers are coin operated at 25 cents for about 2 minuets. Bring soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, hairbrush and towels (one for showering and one for swimming).
- **Sleeping.** Kids will be sleeping in tents. Bring a warm sleeping bag and pillow.
- **Money.** Registrations covers food, lodging, activities and crafts – but if you want snacks or souvenirs, bring spending money. As a group we will visit the campground store where you can buy an ice cream and other souvenirs.
- **General.** Bring a water bottle and small backpack for daytime adventures.
